As from 1st September 2025 all babies and children of working parents over the age of 9 months as of 1st September will be entitled to 30 hours government funded childcare. Please

ensure that you apply for your 30 hour code from HMRC and forward it to me with the NI number so that I can process the code before the end of August. Please apply within Childcare Choices on your HMRC account and forward your code and NI number to me as soon as possible. If you are issued with a temporary code starting 1 followed by 10 digits then ensure that you forward your permanent code as soon as you receive it.

Health and Safety



Food Reminder: Please ensure your child does not bring nuts, chocolate or sweets in any form to pre-school. Please ensure that

sausages, tomatoes, grapes and olives are chopped lengthways in half as these items are major choking hazards for children at this age. In order to promote 'healthy eating' please only provide one yoghurt and as a maximum one sweet item such as a biscuit or cake and ensure your child has at least one item of fruit or vegetable per day.

Sun cream:



When the weather is forecast to be hot please ensure that you apply sun cream to your child before entering pre-school. Please ensure that

your child still wears shoes that cover their toes. Whilst we are using water to keep children cool outside, please provide crocs, beach or swimming shoes as we have noticed that their wellies are rubbing their legs. Please remember no strappy tops or dresses.



Gate:

Could I please ask all parents and carers who collect before 3pm to wait at the gates when there are children playing outside in our play area. We do have some children who like to run when the gates are open and we need to ensure that all of our children are kept safe. Please ensure that if other adults collect on your behalf that they are also aware. Thank you for your

cooperation.

Due to the demand for early years' places for babies under two and the funding incentive for 30 hours childcare from 1st September 2025 we have decided to restructure our setting to accommodate the demand for spaces within

each age group.

From September, our smaller room will be for our 2026 school cohort and will be limited to 14 spaces. Our babies under two and our 2-3 year olds will be in Acorns and Seedlings in the larger room which will be divided to provide separate areas for the two age groups. This way we will be able to provide activities and opportunities of learning appropriate for each age group.
