Starting School in September 2023: If your child will be 4 years old between 1st September 2022 and 31 August 2023, that is, born between 1 September 2018 and 31

August 2019, they will be entitled to start school in September 2023. You can apply online for a place from Tuesday 1st November until the deadline of Sunday 15th January 2023.

We have so many spare pairs of wellington boots that I will be asking you to select your child's boots from a box and place them under their peg so that they can find them. Hopefully, we will then be able to remove some pairs to make it easier for the children to find their own. If your child does not have a pair at pre-school then you can select some from the remaining pairs. Hope this makes sense.
