30 Hour Funding



If you child is 3 before 1st April 2025 and you are eligible for 30 hours, please log in to the HMRC website and update your claim. I

understand that the funding numbers do not change. However, if you have been issued with a temporary code please ensure that you provide me with your new code as soon as you receive it. Any new funding codes must made before 31st March 2025 to enable them to be valid for the summer term from 1st April 2025. No late validations are accepted by Services for Young Children.

Are you a working parent? Is your child aged 9 months before 1st April 2025? If so, your child may be eligible for the governments' new entitlement for 15 hours

free childcare. Login to your HMRC website and apply as soon as possible, no later than 31st March 2025, for your eligibility code. Please provide me with the code and your NI number ready for verification. Please let me know how you wish to spread the 15 hours during the week.

Please be aware that this will increase to 30 hours funding from 1st September 2025.

Several children have been wearing shoes/trainers with laces, even if these have zips on them, the laces are a major tripping hazard for the children and are unsafe on the climbing frame. Within Saplings the children remove their shoes whilst using the soft play and sensory mats and as part of their independence are encouraged to try to put their own shoes back on.

Wellington boots should be provided for outdoor use and cannot be worn inside on wet days as they create a slipping hazard. If your child is in the smaller room, Acorns and Seedlings, please provide indoor shoes or rubber/plastic soled slippers.
