(Personal, Social and Emotional Development, Communication and Language and Physical Development.) In conclusion we have decided that our 'Acorns' room will return to 'Acorns' and 'Seedlings' with a view to moving children into the bigger room 'Saplings' at about 2.5 years. The main room will accommodate 'Saplings' and 'Seedlings' and we will move children when we think they are ready.

Starting School in September 2025: If your child will be 4 years old between 1st September 2024 and 31 August 2025, that is, born between 1 September 2020 and 31

August 2021, they will be entitled to start school in September 2025. You can apply online for a place from **Friday 1**st **November** until the deadline of **Wednesday 15**th **January 2025**.

General




Gloves and Hats: As the weather is now getting colder, please ensure that your child has mittens/gloves and a hat when appropriate. Please put gloves in their coat

Health and Safety



Hazards of Autumn As you will have noticed we are already experiencing the hazards of Autumn. Berries and leaves are covering the ground and we will do our best to clear these as often as

possible. The trees are variations of Sorbus which although produce red berries, are harmless as has been confirmed by Hampshire County Council. In addition to these we have an Arbutus which is equally safe.

As a matter of good practice, we talk to the children and discourage them from playing with red berries.
