Starting School in September 2024: If your child will be 4 years old between 1st September 2023 and 31 August 2024, that is, born between 1 September 2019 and 31

August 2020, they will be entitled to start school in September 2024. You can apply online for a place from Wednesday 1st November until the deadline of Monday 15th January 2024.

Your child will be given a card to assist with their application.
