Health and Safety



Pergola: Please be aware that we have reported rot damage to one of the main structural supports of our pergola. The use of the ramp is temporarily out of use to the main entrance of the building. This does not impact on the safety of the building but will mean that children will not be playing adjacent to the building until the pergola is structurally safe at the far end..

Health and Safety



Food Reminder: Please ensure your child does not bring nuts, chocolate or sweets in any form to pre-school. Please ensure that sausages, tomatoes, grapes and olives are chopped lengthways in half as these items are major choking hazards for children at this age. In order to promote 'healthy eating' please only provide one yoghurt and as a maximum one sweet item such as a biscuit or cake and ensure your child has at least one item of fruit or vegetable per day.

Sun cream:



When the weather is forecast to be hot please ensure that you apply sun cream to your child before entering pre-school. Please ensure that your child still wears shoes that cover their toes. Whilst we are using water to keep children cool outside, please provide crocs, beach or swimming shoes as we have noticed that their wellies are rubbing their legs.

Lost Items:



It saddens me to ask parents to please be courteous to my staff when items go missing. They are all working extremely hard with unquestionable patience and deserve the same respect that we promote to the children they care for. Please remember it is very difficult to remember all of the childrens' belongings and although we are encouraging them to place items on their pegs or in their drawers it is a long process.

Organisation:



Due to the demand for early years' places for babies under two and the funding incentive for 15 hours childcare from 1st September 2024 we have decided to restructure our setting to accommodate the demand for spaces within each age group.

From September, our smaller room will be for babies under two and as such we do not need to divide the room enabling the under two's to have a separate area as per the statutory guidance as they will have the entire room. We have created a smaller area for those babies who are pre-walkers.

Our main room will return to being for children ages two to five and my intention is to leave this as a room where all children will have access to all of the areas. Even though our cohort for next year is very young, I am intending to have a member of staff working closely with our two year olds to ensure their safety in the larger room.

Vicky will be Supervisor

Clare will be Two Year Old Leader

Louise will be Acorns' leader (running the smaller room).
