Parking



Please do not park in front of the emergency exit gate and please be considerate when parking near to the school. There are sufficient spaces at the parade of shops so please use these whenever possible or use the available space outside the front of Burnham Copse Primary school. Please ensure that this information is passed on to any other adult responsible for collecting your child at any time during the year. If any parent or child holds a blue parking badge please see me so that I can discuss where to park with the Headteacher of the school.

Be Ready to Enter pre-school with your coat hung up, registration tag and drink in your hands and if necessary, change bag ready to be handed over to a member of staff. Lunch boxes on the blue trolley.



Acorns' babies can hand all items to a member of staff. Thank you for your cooperation with this.



Open Door Policy We operate an 'open door' policy where you can come in and have a chat when you drop off or collect. If you are wishing to chat at the end of the day please ensure that you arrive early for collection so that we are still able to be closed on time. If you notice that your child is in different clothes and a member of staff has not told you why, then please ask as sometimes staff simply forget to pass on the message. There is always so much to remember at the end of the day so your understanding is appreciated with this.

Lunches



Please clearly label your child's lunch bag/box and drinks bottle on the outside. Please try to limit their lunch to four items. It is much better for your child to eat all of their lunch than be overwhelmed with the content. If you wish to provide more choice please reduce the quantity of each.

Please ensure there are **no sweets or chocolate** and provide at least one item of fruit or vegetable per day to encourage healthy eating. Alternatives to sandwiches can be put in lunch boxes.

We request that **no nuts or nut products** are consumed on the premises eg peanut butter, Nutella, pesto and fruit and nut bars. Should these items be brought into pre-school your child will not be allowed to eat them.

Please could you ensure that grapes, tomatoes, olives and cocktail sausages are chopped lengthways as these are major choking hazards for children of this age.

Organisation

Health and Safety



Outdoor Policy: It is our policy to use sun cream during periods of hot weather and you will be asked to provide your own if your child cannot use Nivea factor 50 that we provide. In all cases a signature must be obtained to enable us to apply cream to your child. Children are also required to wear a hat during hot weather. It is also our policy to ensure children have appropriate footwear, so no open toes shoes/sandals please and please provide wellington boots for use in the garden area at all times. This helps to keep the classroom as clean as physically possible.

Medication or creams:

Please ensure that these are handed to a member of staff and with the exception of sun cream, nappy creams and teething gels, must be prescribed by your GP for us to administer it. All medication must be signed for before it is administered. Do not leave in your child's bag including sun cream as other children may be allergic to it.

Inhalers



Please note that inhalers must be provided in their labelled box.

Education



Starting School in September 2025: If your child will be 4 years old between 1st September 2024 and 31 August 2025, that is, born between 1 September 2020 and 31 August 2021, they will be entitled to start school in September 2025. You can apply online for a place. Look out for details of school open days. I will forward dates and times as soon as I know them.

Planning



We will be welcoming all children and talking about their families, their summer and keeping safe, washing hands, keeping hands off face, away from eyes and noses.

Key Worker and Buddie



Many staff are currently working on a part time basis within the setting. Your child has been allocated a key worker for the term but in most cases your child's key worker is not present on all days that your child attends. Therefore, it is important that you familiarize yourself with your child's allocated 'buddie'. Key Worker lists are displayed on the parent board in the entrance area.

This includes 30 hr gge 3-4 funding and age 2 funding if applicable and all 15 hour funding from 9 months .

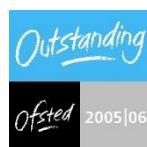
